CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is “DAVID DOUGLAS BOTANICAL GARDEN SOCIETY.”
2. The purposes of the society are:
 - a) to design, construct, maintain and operate a botanical garden and related facilities and structures at UNBC or such other locations as the Directors see fit.
 - b) to promote and encourage public interest and education in environmentally sustainable horticulture and arboriculture in Northern British Columbia.
 - c) to promote and carry on research and to assist and collaborate with other educational institutions, organizations and government bodies conducting research in the field of horticulture and arboriculture.
